CHAINS

A hemlock, 10 ins. diam., bears S.40*30'E., 48 lks. dist., marked T. 30 S R 2 W S 6 B T (Old B.T.)

Land, mountainous.

Soil, gravelly, 3rd rate.

Timber, fir, cedar, pine and hemlock.

Undergrowth, snowbrush, maple, rhododendron and young timber

Resurvey West Bdy., T. 29 S., R. 2 W.

Retracements

From the closing cor. of Tps. 29 and 30 S., R. 2 W., North retracing the W. bdy. of sec. 31; at 6.06 chs. intersect the $\frac{1}{4}$ cor. of sec. 36; at 40.00 chs. set temp. $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor., and at 45.04 chs. fall 15 lks. E. of the cor. of secs. 25, 30, 31 and 36.

From the cor. of secs. 25, 30, 31 and 36, North retracing E bdy. of sec. 25; at 37.78 chs. fall 40 lks. E. of the $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor., and at 75.77 chs. fall 40 lks. E. of the cor. of secs. 19, 24, 25 and 30.

From the cor. of secs. 19, 24, 25 and 30, North retracing E bdy. of sec. 24; at 38.95 chs. fall 32 lks. E. of the $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor.

From the $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor., North retracing the E. bdy. of sec. 24; at 40.00 chs. find no trace of the cor. of secs. 13, 18, 19 and 24, set temp. cor. and continue line along E. bdy. of sec. 13; at 80.00 chs. no trace of the $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor., set temp. cor., and at 120.12 chs. fall 291 lks. W. of the cor. of secs. 7, 12, 13 and 18.

From the cor. of secs. 7, 12, 13 and 18, North retracing E. bdy. of sec. 12; at 39.76 chs. fall 65 lks. E. of the old $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor., and at 78.48 chs. fall 52 lks. W. of the cor. of secs. 1, 6, 7 and 12.

From the cor. of secs. 1, 6, 7 and 12, North retracing E bdy. of sec. 1; at 40.38 chs. fall 61 lks. E. of the old $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor., and at 78.75 chs. fall 208 lks. W. of the cor. of Tps. 29 S., Rs. 2 and 3 W.

From the closing cor. of Tps. 29 and 30 S., R. 2 W., previously described.

North, resurveying W. bdy. of sec. 31.

Ascend through heavy timber and dense undergrowth.

0.25 Spring branch, 1 lk. wide, course SE.

6.06 Intersect the $\frac{1}{4}$ cor. of E. bdy. of sec. 36, which is a slate stone, firmly set, marked and witnessed as described.
