

Resurvey West Bdy., T. 29 S., R. 2 W.

CHAINS

A fir, 40 ins. diam., bears N.77°E., 93 lks. dist.,
marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S 19 B T.

No other bearing tree available; raise a mound of
stone, 2 ft. base, $1\frac{1}{2}$ ft. high, E. of cor.

44.00 Leave burn; enter heavy timber, bears E. and W.

51.80 top of spur, slopes NW.; descend.

77.00 Leave live timber; enter burn, bears E. and W.

79.86 Apportioned distance.

Set a basalt stone, 15x8x6 ins., 10 ins. in the ground,
for $\frac{1}{4}$ cor. of sec. 13, T. 29 S., R. 3 W. only, marked
 $\frac{1}{4}$ on W. face; from which

A fir, 18 ins. diam., bears S.28°30'W., 101 lks. dist.,
marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S 13 B T.

A fir, 34 ins. diam., bears N.34°W., 241 lks. dist.,
marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S 13 B T.

80.02 Set a basalt stone, 18x12x7 ins., 12 ins. in the ground,
for cor. of secs. 18 and 19, marked with 3 notches on N.
and S. edges; from which

A fir, 42 ins. diam., bears N.1°45'E., 263 lks. dist.,
marked T 29 S R 2 W S 18 B T.

A fir, 24 ins. diam., bears S.32°E., 217 lks. dist.,
marked T 29 S R 2 W S 19 B T.

Land, mountainous.

Soil, gravelly and rocky, 3rd rate.

Timber, fir, cedar and hemlock.

Undergrowth, rhododendron, maple and chinquapin.

N.1°23'E., resurveying W. bdy. of sec. 18.

Descend NW. slope, through old burn.

4.00 Draw, course NW.

7.00 Trail, bears NW. and SE.; leave old burn; enter heavy
timber and dense undergrowth, bears E. and W.

14.10 Draw, course NW.

28.50 Days creek, 15 lks. wide, course W.; ascend S. slope.

32.00 Trail, bears E. and W.
