sec. cors. at intervals of 40.00 chs., and at 123.62 chs. intersect the cor. of secs. 34 and 35, on the S. bdy. of T. 28 S., R. 2 W.

Retracements

From the cor. of secs. 34 and 35, on the S. bdy. of T. 28 S., R. 2 W., West retracing S. bdy. of sec. 34; at 40.22 chs. fall 2 lks. S. of the $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor., and at 80.22 chs. fall 6 lks. N. of the cor. of secs. 33 and 34.

From the cor. of secs. 33 and 34, West retracing S. bdy. of sec. 33; at 40.07 chs. fall 6 lks. S. of the $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor., and at 80.04 chs. fall 32 lks. N. of the cor. of secs. 32 and 33.

From the cor. of secs. 32 and 33, West retracing S. bdy. of sec. 32; at 39.87 chs. fall 11 lks. N. of the $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor., and at 79.89 chs. fall 16 lks. S. of the cor. of secs. 31 and 32.

From the cor. of secs. 31 and 32, West retracing S. bdy. of sec. 31; at 39.79 chs. fall 1 lk. N. of the $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. and at 79.68 chs. fall 24 lks. N. of the cor. of Tps. 28 S., Rs. 2 and 3 W.

From the cor. of Tps. 28 S., Rs. 2 and 3 W., West retracing S bdy. of sec. 36, T. 28 S., R. 3 W. and at 38.61 chs. fall 1 lk. N. of the cor. of Tps. 29 S., Rs. 2 and 3 W.

From the cor. of Tps. 29 S., Rs. 2 and 3 W., previously described.

N.89°59'E., resurveying N. bdy. of sec. 6.

14.80 Descend NE. slope, through heavy timber and dense undergrowth Myrtle Creek, 20 lks. wide, course NW.; ascend.

Leave heavy timber; enter partly burned timber, bears NW. and SE.

38.61 Intersect the cor. of Tps. 28 S., Rs. 2 and 3 W., which is a granite stone, firmly set, marked and witnessed as described by the surveyor general. As both bearing trees are now dead, I mark new trees, as follows: from cor.

A fir, 30 ins. diam., bears N.80°E., 48 lks. dist., marked T 28 S R 2 W. S31 B T.

A fir, 50 ins. diam., bears N.50°30'W., 32 lks. dist., marked T 28 S R 3 W S 36 B T.

Thence

N.89°40'E., continuing my measurements.

42.06 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 26 ins. in the ground, for $\frac{1}{4}$ cor. of sec. 6 only, with brass cap marked
