

Resurvey and Survey North Bdy., T. 29 S., R. 2 W.

CHAINS

A fir, 14 ins. diam., bears S.45*W., 35 lks. dist.,
marked T 29 S R 2 W S 2 B T.

Land, mountainous.

Soil, rocky, 3rd rate.

Timber, fir, hemlock and pine.

Undergrowth, rhododendron, chinquapin, and young timber.

East, surveying N. bdy. of sec. 1.

Ascend through heavy timber and dense undergrowth.

- 5.00 Top of spur, slopes NE.; descend.
- 17.83 Top of spur, slopes NE.; continue descend.
- 25.62 Ravine, course NE.; ascend.
- 29.93 Top of spur, slopes NE.; descend.
- 36.38 Set a basalt stone, 15x6x6 ins.; 10 ins. in the ground,
for cor. of secs. 35 and 36, T. 28 S.; R. 2 W. only,
marked with 5 notches on the W. and 1 notch on E. edge;
from which
 - A fir, 10 ins. diam., bears N.75*E., 7 lks dist.,
marked T 28 S R 2 W S 36 B T.
 - A fir, 18 ins. diam., bears N.35*W., 51 lks. dist.,
marked T 28 S R 2 W S 35 B T.
- 37.75 Creek, 1 lk. wide, course NE.; ascend.
- 40.00 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 26 ins. in the
ground, for $\frac{1}{4}$ cor. of sec. 1 only, with brass cap marked

$$\frac{1}{4}S1$$

 from which
 - A fir, 18 ins. diam., bears S.24*15'E., 33 lks. dist.,
marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S 1 B T.
 - A fir, 10 ins. diam., bears S.51*30'W., 8 lks. dist.,
marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S 1 B T.
- 40.75 Spring branch, course N.
- 43.50 Top of spur, slopes N.; descend.
- 56.90 Head of draw, course N.; ascend.
- 62.95 Top of spur, slopes NE.; descend.
