80.14 The cor. of secs. 26 27, 34 and 35.

Land, mountainous.

Soil, dark loose loam, 1st to 3rd rate.

Timber, fir, pine, cedar, ash and maple.

Undergrowth, maple, willow and wild lilac.

N.0*07'E., bet secs. 26 and 27.

Descend through heavy timber and dense undergrowth.

2.82 Creek, 2 lks. wide, in Hog Gulch, course NE.; continue descent.

11.15 West Fork of Deadman Creek, 25 lks. wide, course E.; ascend.

14.00 Trail, bears E. and W.

40.00 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 26 ins. in the ground, for $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor., with brass cap marked.
