Land, mountainous.

Soil, rocky, 3rd rate.

Timber, fir, cedar, pine and laurel.

Undergrowth, maple, laurel and young timber.

N.89*56'E., on a random line, bet. secs. 23 and 26.

40.00 Set temp. $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor.

80.26 Intersect the N. and S. line, 23 lks. N. of the cor. of
secs. 23, 24, 25 and 26.

Thence

N.89*54'W., on a true line, bet. secs. 23 and 26.

0.75 Deadman Creek, 25 lks. wide, course S.; ascend E. slope.

9.80 Top of Spur, slopes SE.; descend.

19.10 Creek, 1 lk. wide, course SE.

40.13 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 26 ins. in the
