CHAINS

N.0*07'E., bet. secs. 22 and 23.

Ascend through heavy timber and dense undergrowth.

23.70 Top of spur, slopes SE., descend.

30.00 Head of draw, course E.; ascend SE. slope.

40.00 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 26 ins. in the ground, for $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor., with brass cap marked

A fir, 24 ins. diam., bears N.52*45'W., 21 lks. dist., marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S 22 B T.

This cor. is 1.00 ch. E. of the top of a ridge, which bears N. and S.

Along E. slope.

80.00 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 2 ins. diam., 24 ins. in the ground, for cor. of secs. 14, 15, 22 and 23, with brass cap marked.

A fir, 12 ins. diam., bears S.60*W., 11 lks. dist., marked T 29 S R 2 W S22 B T.

A fir, 18 ins. diam., bears N.38*45'W. 63 lks. dist., marked T 29 S R 2 W S 15 B T.

Timber, fir, pine and cedar.

Undergrowth, rhododendron and chinquapin.
