40.00 Set temp.  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. cor.

79.92 Intersect the N. and S. line, 18 lks. N. of the cor. of  
 secs. 26, 27 34 and 35.

Thence

S.89\*57'W., on a true line, bet. secs. 27 and 34.

Descend though heavy timber and dense undergrowth.

0.70 Creek on Hog Gulch, 2 lks. wide, course NE.; ascend.

13.30 Top of spur, slopes NE.; along N. slope.

39.96 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 26 ins. in the  
 ground, for  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. cor., with brass cap marked

79.92 The cor. of secs. 27, 28, 33 and 34.

Land, mountainous.

Soil, dark gravelly loam, 2nd and 3rd rate.

Timber, fir, pine and cedar.

Undergrowth, maple and rhododendron.
