79.78 The cor. of secs. 20, 21, 28 and 29.
Land, mountainous.
Soil, loose gravelly loam, 3rd rate.
Timber, fir and pine.
Undergrowth, maple, laurel and young timber.

N.0*06'E., bet. secs. 20 and 21.
Descend through heavy timber and dense undergrowth.
2.20 Creek, 4 lks. wide, course NE.; ascend.
8.65 Top of spur, slopes, E.; descend.
17.20 Draw, course SE.; ascend.
29.00 Along NE. slope.
30.00 Descend NE. slope.
32.70 Creek, 3 lks. wide, course E.; ascend.
40.00 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 26 ins. in the ground, for $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor., with brass cap marked.
