Subdivision of T. 29 S., R. 2 W.

CHAINS

Undergrowth, rhododendron, maple and chinqupin.

N.0°05'E., bet secs. 7 and 8.

Ascend through heavy timber and dense undergrowth.

2.00 Top of spur, slopes SW., descend.

17.00 Top of spur, slopes NW.; continue descent.

29.40 Draw, course NW.

31.00 Creek, 2 lks. wide, course SW.; ascend.

39.00 Top of spur, slopes W.; descend.

40.00 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 26 ins. in the ground, for $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor., with brass cap marked

44.30 Creek, 3 lks. wide, course W., ascend.

80.00 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 2 ins. diam., 24 ins. in the ground, for cor. of secs. 5, 6, 7 and 8, with brass cap marked

A fir, 8 ins. diam., bears S.82°E., 47 lks. dist., marked T 29 S R 2 W S 8 B T.

A fir, 10 in. diam., bears S.41°30'W., 15 lks. dist., marked T 29 S R 2 W S 7 B T.

A fir, 10 ins. diam., bears N.74°W., 19 lks. dist., marked T.29S R 2 W S 6 B T.
