1.00 Creek, 1 lk. wide, C. SE.

40.00 Set Yew post for $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor., from which

A Fir, 30 ins. diam., bears S.20*E., 9 lks.

A Fir, 24 ins. diam., bears West, 16 lks.

46.50 Creek, 2 lks. wide, C. SE.

66.00 Enter marshy flat.

70.00 Leave same.

80.00 Set Cedar post for cor. to Secs. 1, 6, 7, 12, from
which

A Laurel, 15 ins. diam., bears N.8*E., 45 lks.

A Fir, 18 ins. diam., bears S.72*E., 24 lks.

A Fir, 30 ins. diam., bears S.20*W., 18 lks.

A Fir, 28 ins. diam., bears N.48*W., 50 lks.

30.00 Enter broken rocky slide.

40.00 Set Hemlock post for $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor., from which

A Fir, 15 ins. diam., bears N.30*W., 21 lks.

A Hemlock, 20 ins. diam., bears S.40*E., 30 lks.

70.00 Leave rocky slide.

80.00 Set temp. cor.

78.95 Established permanent cor. to Tps. 28 and 29 S., Ranges
2 and 3 West.

Land, mountainous, rocky, broken, 3rd rate.

Timber, small, chiefly Fir.
