A W. Oak, 9 ins. diam., bears S.68\*W., 23 lks. dist.

A W. Oak, 11 ins. diam., bears S.5\*E., 30 lks. dist.

A Black Oak, 12 ins. diam., bears N.39\*E., 52 lks. dist.

N.  $\frac{1}{2}$  of line runs in a ravine. S.  $\frac{1}{2}$  is along the hill side, which descends East.
