CHAINS	
	N.0*2'W. on a true line bet. secs. 31 and 32. Over mountainous land through heavy timber and dense undergrowth. Asc. S. Slope.
3.35	Blazed trail bears E. and W.
14.85	Leave heavy timber, bears NE. and SW. Enter grassy opening on S. slope of mountain.
16.35	Summit of divide bet. Rice and Olalla creeks bears E. and W. Desc. N. Slope.
18.35	Enter heavy timber, bears E. and W.
39.85	Set an ironstone 12 x 10 x 6 ins. 8 ins. in the ground for 1/4 sec. cor., marked 1/4 on W. face, from which: A red fir, 12 ins. diam., bears N.28*E., 39 lks. dist., marked 1/4 S 32 B T A maple, 8 ins. diam., bears S.37*W., 29 lks. dist., marked 1/4 S 31 B T
60.50	Top of steep descent.
65.80	Creek, 3 lks. wide, course NW. Asc. along SW. slope.
68.85	Enter rocky opening.
76.35	Leave opening. Enter heavy timber.
79.85	The cor. of secs. 29, 30, 31 and 32. Land, mountainous. Soil, clay and stony, 2nd and 3rd. rate. Timber; red and white fir, sugar and yellow pine, cedar. Undergrowth; arrow wood, hazel, vine maple and chapparal. Mountainous or heavily timbered land or land covered with dense undergrowth, 79.85 chs.
