A Laurel, 16 ins. diam., bears S.54*E., 59 lks. dist., marked T 29 S R 6 W S 31 B T.

A Laurel, 16 ins. diam., bears S.15*W., 40 lks. dist., marked T 29 S R 7 W S 36 B T.

A Laurel, 8 ins. diam., bears N.49*W., 29 lks. dist., marked T 29 S R 7 W S 25 B T.

Land, mountainous.

Soil, clay and stony, 2nd and 3rd. rate.

Timber, red fir, sugar and yellow pine, cedar, laurel.

Undergrowth, arrowwood, vinemaple, fir and laurel.

Mountainous or heavily timbered land or land covered with dense undergrowth, 78.80 chs.

S.2*30'W. on a true line, bet. secs. 31 and 36.

Over mountainous land through heavy timber and dense undergrowth.

Ascend gradually along W. slope.

Ascend N. slope.
