CHAINS

Timber, densely covered with Fir, Pine, Laurel, Cedar and Oak.

Undergrowth, thick, Fir, Oak, and Cedar, with Hazel, Poison Oak and Arrow wood.

South 87°59'W., on a true line, between secs. 4 and 33.
Va. 19°30'E.

- 21.88 Ascend steep, rocky bluff, Course SW.
- 22.70 Top of same.

- 25.50 A creek, 2 lks. wide, Course SE.

- 80.00 Set a stone, 14 x 12 x 6 ins., 10 ins. in ground, for the corner to secs. 4, 5, 32 and 33, marked with 4 notches on the East and 2 notches on the West angles of the same and from which,
