A Cedar, 18 ins. diam., bears N.54\*E., 15 lks. dist.

Marked T 29 S R 7 W S 33 B T.

A Laurel, 15 ins. diam., bears S.20\*E., 32 lks. dist.

Marked T 30 S R 7 W S 4 B T.

A Pine, 44 ins. diam., bears S.42\*W., 138 lks. dist.

Marked T 30 S R 7 W S 5 B T.

A Pine, 44 ins. diam., bears N.72\*W., 106 lks. dist.

Marked T 29 S R 7 W S 32 B T.

Land, steep, mountainous and broken.

Soil, rocky, fourth rate.

Timber, generally densely covered with Fir, Pine, Laurel and Cedar.

Undergrowth, thick, Pine and Cedar, Hazel, Live-Oak, Oak, Poison-Oak and Arrow wood.

September 22, 1882.

South, 87\*59'W., on a true line, between secs. 5 and 32.

Va. 19\*30'E.

40.00 Set a stone, 15 x 12 x 10 ins. in ground for the  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. corner, marked  $\frac{1}{4}$  on the North face, and from which,

An Oak, 18 ins. diam., bears N.86\*W., 42 lks. dist.

Marked  $\frac{1}{4}$  S. B T.

An Oak, 14 ins. diam., bears S.24\*W., 27 lks. dist.

Marked  $\frac{1}{4}$  S. B T.

Along North sidehill.

58.70 Wagon road, Course N. and S.

60.00 Steep descent.

68.50 Olalla creek, 60 lks. wide, Course N.

72.00 Steep ascent.
