1.27	Summit of ridge bears E. and W. Thence along W. slope.
9.20	Hunter's trail bears E. and W.

11.50	Summit of ridge bears NW. and SE.
	Desc. SW. slope.
26.47	Gulch, C. NW.
	Asc. NE. slope.
	Enter heavy timber, bears NW. and SE.
32.87	Summit of ridge bears NW. and SE.
	Desc. SW. slope.
39.60	Creek, 4 lks. wide, C. NW. Asc. N. slope.
41.10	A red fir, 30 ins. diam., for $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. corner, I mark $\frac{1}{4}$ S 4 on W. side and 3 on E. side; from which A hemlock, 14 ins. diam., bears S.12*E., 40 lks. dist., marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S 3 B T. A white fir, 12 ins. diam., bears N.87*W., 22 lks. dist., marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S 4 B T.
50.60	Foot of rock bluff, 40 ft. high.
51.10	Top of bluff.
58.50	Foot of rock bluff 30 ft. high.
59.00	Top of bluff.
81.10	The corner of secs. 3 and 4 on the sectional correction line.
	Land, mountainous.
	Soil, loam and stony, second and third rate.
