Therefore, I start at the cor. of secs. 8, 9, 16 and 17, which I re-established August 8, 1905.</p> <p>August 11: at 8 a. m., l. m. t., I set off 42 58' N. on the lat. arc; 15 22' N on the decl. arc and determine a meridian with the solar at the cor. of secs 8, 9, 16 & 17.</p> <p>Thence I run</p> <p>North on a random line bet secs. 8 and 9.</p>
40.00	Set temp $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor.
82.00	Intersect E. and W. line 75 lks. E. of cor. of secs. 4, 5, 8 and 9.
	<p>Thence I run</p> <p>South on a true line bet. secs. 8 and 9.</p> <p>Over mountainous land through heavy timber and dense undergrowth.</p> <p>Ascend N slope of mountain.</p>
8.50	Enter willow swamp.
10.30	Leave swamp.
23.86	Gulch, course NW.
39.97	enter small swamp.
40.50	Leave swamp.

42.00	<p>Set a slate stone 12x8x6 ins. 8 ins. in the ground, for $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. marked $\frac{1}{4}$ on W face, from which:</p> <p>A red firm 10 ins. diam. bears N. 2° E. 61 lks. dist. marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S 9 BT.</p> <p>A maple 10 ins. diam. bears S. 52° W. 37 lks. dist. marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S 8 BT.</p>
