The resulting lat. is 42°59' or nearly the proper lat.</p> <p>Descend along NE. slope.</p>

Soil, loam and stony, 2nd and 3d rate. Timber, red and white fir, sugar and yellow pine, cedar. Undergrowth, hazel, vine maple, arrowwood, fir. Mountainous or heavily timbered land or land covered with dense undergrowth, 80.00 chains.</p>
