

Resurvey of East Bdy., T. 30 S., R. 2 W.

CHAINS

for corner of secs. 7, 12, 13 and 18, marked with 2 notches on N. and 4 notches on S. edge, from which

A sugar pine, 15 ins. diam., bears N.18*E., 39 lks. dist., marked T 30 S R 1 W S 7 B T.

A fir, 8 ins. diam., bears S.88*E., 39 lks. dist., marked T 30 S R 1 W S 18 B T.

A fir, 20 ins. diam., bears S.48*W., 36 lks. dist., marked T 30 S R 2 W S 13 B T.

A fir, 15 ins. diam., bears N.30*W., 31 lks. dist., marked T 30 S R 2 W S 12 B T.

Thence, I run

N.0*8'E. on E. bdy. sec. 12.

Over mountainous land, heavily timbered and covered with dense undergrowth.

Desc. NE. slope.

7.45 Deadman Creek, 30 lks. wide, C. SE.

40.00 Set a basalt stone 14x10x6 ins., 9½ ins. in the ground for ¼ sec. corner on E. bdy. secs. 12, marked ¼ on W. face, from which

A fir, 10 ins. diam., bears S.69*W., 27 lks. dist., marked ¼ S 12 B T.

A white oak, 5 ins. diam., bears N.58*W., 48 lks. dist., marked ¼ S 12 B T.

40.50 I re-establish the old ¼ sec. corner in its original position as the ¼ sec. corner on W. bdy. sec. 7, T. 30 S., R 1 W., only, as follows

The original corner, a fir 30 ins. diam., for ¼ sec. corner on W. bdy. sec. 7, I mark ¼ S 7 on E. side, from which

A yellow pine, 18 ins. diam., bears N.25*E., 36 lks. dist., marked ¼ S 7 B T.

A black oak, 8 ins. diam., bears S.85*E., 31 lks. dist., marked ¼ S 7 B T.
