Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 2 ins. diam., 28 ins. in  
the ground, for cor. of secs. 4, 5, 32 and 33, with  
brass cap marked

East, on a true line, on S. bdy. of sec. 33.

Over mountainous land, through heavy timber and dense  
undergrowth.

- 0.96 Creek, 3 lks. wide, C. SE.
- 1.23 Creek, 2 lks. wide, C. SE.; thence along general S.  
slope.
- 2.55 A fir, 36 ins. diam., on line, marked with 2 notches on  
E. and W. sides.
- 2.99 Beaver Creek trail, bears NW. and SE.
- 5.57 Same trail, bears NE. and SW.
- 13.16 Enter creek, 3 lks. wide, comes from SW., flows E.
- 14.31 Leave creek, C. NE.
- 18.88 W. edge of small pond, bears N. and S.
- 19.88 E. edge of small pond, bears N. and S.
- 38.00 40.00 chs. westing from the closing cor. of secs. 3 and  
4, determined as hereinafter described.
