CHAINS

Retracement

set by Deputy Hathorn, determined as hereinafter set forth.

The bearing and length of the W. half mile is S.89*39'E., 39.68 chs., and of the E. half mile is N.89*18'E., 39.99 chs.

Land, mountainous.

Soil, clay loam, second rate.

Timber, fir, pine, cedar.

Undergrowth, lilac, hazel, laurel.

Retracement

From the $\frac{1}{4}$ cor. on the old E. bdy. of sec. 12

South, retracing old E. bdy. of sec. 12

40.00 After diligent search find no evidence of the old cor. of secs. 12 and 13.

Thence

South on old E. bdy. of sec. 13, continuing measurement.

81.16 Fall 47 lks. E. of the $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. on old E. bdy. of sec. 13.

The bearing and length of this line is S.0*20'W., 81.16 chs. and proportional length of each half mile is 40.58 chs.

Resurvey

From the $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. on the old E. bdy. of sec. 12, established by Deputy Hathorn, located by reference to the original bearing trees, which are in agreement with the field notes.

At exact corner point (no iron post available)

Set a basalt stone, 24x8x6 ins., 18 ins. in the ground for $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of original sec. 12, marked, $\frac{1}{4}$ S12 on W. face, from which
