CHAINS

- 40.00 Set a stone 14x10x8 ins. 10 ins. in the ground for $\frac{1}{2}$ sec. cor. marked $\frac{1}{2}$ on N. face, from which,
 A Fir, 16 ins. diam., bears N. $41\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$ E., 12 $\frac{1}{2}$ lks. dist. marked $\frac{1}{2}$ S B T.
 A Fir, 5 ^{ins}ft. diam., bears $72\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$ E., 28 lks. dist., marked $\frac{1}{2}$ S B T.
- 49.25 A spring branch 1 lk. wide, course NE.
- 62.55 A ravine, course NW. and SE.
- 78.50 Top of ridge, course NE. and SW. descend
- 80.00 Set a stone 14x10x4 ins. 10 ins. in the ground for closing cor. to sec. 32 and 33, marked C C on N face with 4 notches on E and 2 notches on W faces, from which,
 A Fir, 16 ins. diam. bears N. $75\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$ E., 13 lks., dist. marked T 30 S, R 3 W, S 33 B T.
 A Fir, 22 ins. diam., bears N. $41\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$ W, 26 lks. dist., marked T 30 S, R 3 W, S 32 B T.
 A Fir, 18 ins. diam., bears S. $15\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$ E., 11 lks. dist. marked T 30 S, R 3 W, C C S 32 & 33 B T
- Soil, third rate.
- Land, mountainous 80.00 chs.
- Heavily timbered with Fir, Laurel, Cedar and Maple, 80.00 chs.
- Dense undergrowth of Vine-Maple, Laurel, Hemlock, Arrowwood, Hazel, Thimbleberry, Huckleberry and Fir, 75.00 chs.

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
