

Retracement. of West Bdy. of T. 30 S., R 2 W.

CHAINS

September 1: At 8 A.M. l.m.t. I set off  $42^{\circ}59'$  on the lat. arc.  $8^{\circ}23'N$ . on the decl. arc and determine as meridian with the solar at the closing cor. of Tps. 29 and 30 S. R 2 W.

Thence I run South on W. bdy. sec. 6, over mountainous land, heavily timbered and covered with dense undergrowth, along E. slope.

- 4.50 Ridge, point descending E.
- 5.50 Ravine, course E.
- 7.50 Ridge, point descending E.
- 19.85 Ravine, course E.
- 27.50 Ridge; point descending E.
- 32.86 The old cor. of Tps. 29 S. R's 2 and 3 W, which I re-established as the cor. of Tps. 29 S, R 3 W, and 30 S, R 2 W, as follows  
 The original cor. a fir 20 ins. diam., for cor. of Tps 29 S, R 3 W and 30 S, R 2 W, I re-mark T 30 S, R 2 W, S 6 on NE. and T 29 S, R 3 W, S 36 on NW. side with 6 notches on N and W sides, from which  
 A Fir, 18 ins. diam., bears  $N 55\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}E$ ., 91 lks. distant marked T 30 S, R 2 W, S 6 B T.  
 A Fir, 15 ins. diam., bears  $N.45^{\circ}W$ . 4 lks dist, marked T 29 S, R 3 W, S 36 BT .  
 I obliterate marks on former bearing tree referring to T 29 S, R 2 W.  
 Land, mountainous.  
 Soil, stony and loam, second and fourth rate.  
 Timber, Fir, Hemlock,  
 Undergrowth, Hemlock, Fir, Snowbrush, Vine-Maple,  
 Hazel.
