

## Retracements of West Bdy. of T. 30 S., R. 2 W.

CHAINS

East on S. bdy. rectangular fraction of sec. 6.  
Over mountainous land, heavily timbered and covered  
with dense undergrowth.

Desc. along N. slope.

The old closing cor. of Tp 30 S, R 2 and 3 W, I re-  
establish this cor. in its original position as the  
NE. cor. of T 30 S, R 3 W, only as follows,

The old post is badly decayed, set a sandstone  
18x8x4 ins. 12 ins. in the ground for NE cor. of  
T 30 S, R 3 W, marked with 6 notches on S and W  
edges, from which,

A Fir, 10 ins. diam., bears S.68\*W., 36 lks. dist.  
marked T 30 S, R 3 W, S 1 B T.

Obliterate marks on former bearing tree referring to  
T 30 S, R 2 W.

Land, mountainous.

Soil, loam, third rate.

Timber, Fir, Hemlock,

Undergrowth, Hemlock, Vine-Maple.

Mountainous or heavily timbered land or land covered  
with dense undergrowth and exceptionally difficult  
to survey, 2.74 chs.

South on W. bdy. sec. 6

Over mountainous land, heavily timbered and covered  
with dense undergrowth along E. slope.

In its original position, I re-establish the old  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec.  
cor. as the  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. cor. on E. bdy. sec. 1, T 30 S,  
R 3 W, only as follows:

The old post is badly decayed, no stones available,  
Set a madrone post, 3 ft. long 4 in. sq., 24 ins. in  
the ground for  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. cor. on E. bdy. sec. 1, T 30 S,  
R 3 W, marked  $\frac{1}{4}$  S 1 on W face, from which,

A Madrone, 24 in. diam., bears S.41\*W., 10 lks.  
dist. marked  $\frac{1}{4}$  S 1 B T.

A Fir, 36 ins. diam., bears N.57 $\frac{1}{2}$ \*W., 38 lks, dist.
