	Obliterate marks on former bearing tree referring to Section 6.
10.74	A Fir, 36 ins. diam., for $\frac{1}{4}$ Sec. cor. on W bdy. of Sec. 6. I mark $\frac{1}{4}$ S 6 on E side, from which A Fir, 30 ins. diam., bears N.56*E., 68 lks. dist., marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S 6 B T. A Fir, 24 ins. diam., bears S.5*E., 93 lks. dist., marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S 6 B T.
15.00	Begin descent of S slope.
35.00	Creek, 10 lks. wide, course SE., <sup>and</sup> NE slope.
46.54	A Fir, 36 ins. diam., marked with 2 notches on N and S sides.
50.74	The corner of Secs. 1, 6, 7 and 12. Land, mountainous. Soil, loam and stony, second and third rate. Timber, Fir, Hemlock, Madrone. Undergrowth, Hemlock, Hazel, Vinemaple. Mountainous or heavily timbered land or land covered with dense undergrowth and exceptionally difficult to survey. 50.74 chs.
