1.20	Creek, 2 lks. wide, course E.
5.25	Ridge, point descending SE.
8.75	Creek, 1 lk. wide, course E.
12.00	A Sugar Pine, 36 ins. diam., marked with 2 notches on N and S sides.
17.75	Ravine, course E.
26.85	A Fir, 30 ins. diam., marked with 2 notches on N and S sides.
40.01	Set a Fir post (no stones available) 3 ft. long, 4 ins. sq., 24 ins. in the ground for $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. on W. bdy. sec. 18, marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S 18 on E face, from which, A Fir, 18 ins. diam., bears N.40*E., 48 lks. dist. marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S 18 B T. A Sugar Pine, 16 ins. diam., bears S.60*E., 26 lks., dist. marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S 18 B T.
41.41	I re-establish the old $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. in its original position as the $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. on E. bdy. sec. 13, T 30 S, R 3 W, only as follows, No stones available, set a Cedar post 3 ft. long, 4 ins. sq., 24 ins. in the ground for $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. on E bdy. sec. 13, marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S 13 on W face, from which, A Fir, 36 ins. diam., bears S.70*W., 28 lks. dist. marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S 13 B T. A Fir, 16 ins. diam., bears N.71*W., 22 lks. dist. marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S 13 B T.
44.25	Creek, 3 lks. wide, course E.
51.00	A Fir, 36 ins. diam., marked with 2 notches on N and S sides.
60.25	Creek, 1 lk. wide, course NE.
70.50	Trail on ridge, bears E and W.
77.25	Ravine, course SW.
