CHAINS	<p>Timber, Fir, Cedar, Pine, Undergrowth, Fir, Cedar, Hazel.</p> <p>Mountainous or heavily timbered land or land covered with dense undergrowth and exceptionally difficult to survey, 40.44 chs.</p> <p>August 27: At this cor. I set off <math>10^{\circ}6'N.</math>, on the decl. arc. and at 12 H.2 m P.M. 1.m.t. observe the sun on the meridian. The resulting lat. is <math>42^{\circ}57'</math>.</p> <hr/> <p>September 2: At the cor. of secs. 19, 24, 25 and 30 on the W. bdy. of the Tp.</p> <p>Thence I run East on S bdy. sec. 19 Over mountainous land, heavily timbered and covered with dense undergrowth. Along S slope. Creek, 3 lks. wide, course S.</p> <p>16.25 40.40 I re-establish the old <math>\frac{1}{4}</math> sec. cor. in its original position as the <math>\frac{1}{4}</math> sec. cor. on N bdy. sec 30, only as follows: No stones available, set a Fir post 3 ft. long, 4 ins. sq. 24 ins. in the ground for <math>\frac{1}{4}</math> sec. cor. on N bdy. sec. 30, marked <math>\frac{1}{4}</math> S 30 on S face, from which, A Fir, 18 ins. diam., bears <math>S.25^{\circ}E.</math>, 30 lks. dist. marked <math>\frac{1}{4}</math> S 30 B T. A Madrone, 12 ins. diam., bears <math>S.22^{\circ}W.</math>, 32 lks. dist. marked <math>\frac{1}{4}</math> S 30 B T. Marks on former bearing tree referring to sec. 19 are obliterated.</p> <p>41.43 A Fir, 12 ins. diam., for <math>\frac{1}{4}</math> sec. cor. on <del>S</del><sup>S</sup> bdy. sec. 19 I mark <math>\frac{1}{4}</math> S 19 on N side, from which, A Fir, 24 ins. diam., bears <math>N.6\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}E.</math>, 8 lks. dist. marked <math>\frac{1}{4}</math> S 19 B T.</p>
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
