A Fir, 60 ins. diam., bears N.15°W., 16 lks.
dist. marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S 33 B T.
A Cedar, 12 ins. diam., bears S.20°W., 48 lks.
dist. marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S4B T .

48.50 A spring flows N.

52.00 Enter face of slide.

58.00 Leave slide.

75.00 Divide between Deadman and Coffee Creeks bears N and
S.

Descend W. slope.

80.00 Set a porphyry stone 18x10x8 ins., 12 ins. ~~in diam.~~, in
the ground for cor. of secs. 4, 5, 32 and 33, marked
with 4 notches on E and 2 notches on W edge, from
