- 63.00 Trail bears NE and SW.
- 64.50 Mining Ditch, Course S.
- 65.00 Creek "Texas Gulch" 3 lks. wide, course SW.
Ascend SE. slope.
- 68.50 Mining ditch, course S.
- 72.50 Top of ascent, along S. slope.
- 80.00 Set a quartz stone 18x15x6 ins. 12 ins. in the ground,
for cor. of secs. 5, 6, 31 and 32, marked with 5 notches
on E and 1 notch on W edge, from which,
A Fir, 30 ins. diam., bears N.50*E., 75 lks. dist.
marked T 29 S, R 2 W, S 32 B T.
A Fir, 24 ins. diam., bears S.27*E., 18 lks. dist.
marked T 30 S, R 2 W, S 5 B T.
A Fir, 30 ins. diam., bears S.16*W., 46 lks. dist.
marked T 30 S, R 2 W, S 6 B T.
A Fir, 40 ins. diam., bears N.65*W., 16 lks. dist.
marked T 29 S, R 2 W, S 31 B T.
- Land, mountainous.
Soil, clay and stony, second and fourth rate.
Timber, Fir, Cedar, Hemlock,
Undergrowth, Hazel, Snow-brush, Hemlock, Fir.
Mountainous or heavily timbered land or land covered
with dense undergrowth and exceptionally difficult
to survey 80.00 chs.
- August 13: At this cor. I set off 14*43' N. on the decl.
arc. and at 12 h. 5 m. l.m.t. observe the sun on the
meridian. The resulting lat. is 42*59'.
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- West between secs. 6 and 31.
Over mountainous land, heavily timbered and covered
with dense undergrowth.
Ascend along S. slope.
- 10.00 Along ridge, bears W.
- 14.50 Leave ridge.
