CHAINS	Mountainous or heavily timbered land or land covered with dense undergrowth and exceptionally difficult to survey, 80.00 chs.
40.00	S.89*55'E. on a random line bet. secs. 1 and 12. Set temp. $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor.
80.21	Intersect E. bdy. of the Tp., 23 lks. S. of the cor. of secs. 1 and 12. Thence I run S.89*55'W., on a true line bet. secs. 1 and 12. Over mountainous land, heavily timbered and covered with dense undergrowth. Asc. E. slope.
8.00	Ridge bears N. and S. Desc. W. slope.
16.25	Ravine, course SW.
31.75	Deadman Creek, 30 lks. wide, course SW. Asc. E. slope.
32.50	Trail bears N. and S.
36.00	A Sugar Pine, 60 ins. diam., marked with 2 notches on E. and W. sides.
40.10 $\frac{1}{2}$	A cedar, 8 ins. diam., for $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor., I mark $\frac{1}{4}$ S 1 on N. and 12 on S. side, from which, A fir, 7 ins. diam., bears N.39*E., 9 lks. dist., marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S 1 B T. A fir, 7 ins. diam., bears S.48*E., 20 lks. dist., marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S 12 B T.
48.00	Ridge point descending SE. Along S. slope.
68.50	Ravine, course SE. Asc. rocky NE. slope.
