## CHAINS

Land, mountainous.

Soil, clay and stony, 2nd and 4th rate.

Timber, Fir, Cedar, Pine.

Undergrowth, Hazel, Vine Maple, Fir.

Mountainous or heavily timbered land or land covered with dense undergrowth and exceptionally difficult to survey, 80.21 chs.

August 18, 1909.

At the cor. of secs. 1, 2, 11 and 12.

Thence I run

N.0°1'W., on a random line bet. secs. 1 and 2.

40.00 Set temp.  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. cor.

82.14 Intersect N. bdy. of the Tp., 41 lks. W. of the cor. of secs. 1, 2, 35 and 36.

Thence I run

S.0°16'W. on a true line bet. secs. 1 and 2.

Over mountainous land, heavily timbered and covered with dense undergrowth.

Asc. NE. slope.

12.50 Ridge point descending E.

Desc. SE. slope.

20.00 Ravine, course E.

23.00 Ridge bears E. and W.

24.00 Enter swamp.

25.00 Leave swamp.

28.50 Ridge bears E. and W.

32.20 Creek, 1 lk. wide, course NE.

42.14 Set a basalt stone 18x10x10 ins., 12 ins. in the ground, for  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. cor., marked  $\frac{1}{4}$  on W. face, from which,

A Madrone, 10 ins. diam., bears E., 19 lks. dist., marked  $\frac{1}{4}$  S 1 B T.
