29.90 Schulz' fence bears N. and S. Enter clearing.

30.60 Small irrigating ditch, course E.

31.30 Schulz' barn bears E. about 2.00 chs. dist.

33.60 Creek, 2 lks. wide, course E.

38.80 Leave clearing.

42.55 Set a basalt stone 15x8x6 ins., 10 ins. in the  
 ground, for  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. cor., marked  $\frac{1}{4}$  on W. face,  
 from which,  
 A Yew, 5 ins. diam., bears N.34°E., 10 lks.  
 dist., marked  $\frac{1}{4}$  S 2 B T.  
 A Hemlock, 6 ins. diam., bears S.70°W., 29 lks.  
 dist., marked  $\frac{1}{4}$  S 3 B T.

49.00 Ridge point descending NE.

61.00 Ravine, course NE.

74.90 Trail to Buker's, bears E. and W.
