40.00	Set temp. $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor.
83.24	Intersect N. bdy. of the Tp., 2 lks. E. of the cor. of secs. 4, 5, 32, and 33. Thence I run S.0*4'E. on a true line bet. secs. 4 and 5. Over mountainous land, heavily timbered and covered with dense undergrowth. Along W. slope.
9.50	Trail bears E. and W. Desc. S. slope.
41.50	Granite Creek, 3 lks. wide, course SW. Asc. NW. slope.
43.24	Set a slate stone 18x10x10 ins., 12 ins. in the ground, for $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. marked $\frac{1}{4}$ on W. face, from which, A Fir, 15 ins. diam., bears N.75*E., 21 lks. dist. marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S 4 B T. A Fir, 18 ins. diam., bears S.11 $\frac{1}{2}$ *W., 7 lks. dist. marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S 5 B T.
48.75	Ridge bears E. and W. Desc. S. slope.
55.50	Creek, 2 lks. wide, course NW. Ascend NE. slope.
62.25	Creek, 1 lk. wide, course NW.
76.75	Trail on ridge bears E. and W. Desc. S. slope.
83.24	The cor. of secs. 4, 5, 8 and 9. Land, mountainous. Soil, clay and stony, 2nd and 3rd rate. Timber, Fir, Cedar, Hemlock, Pine. Undergrowth, Vine Maple, Hazel, Hemlock. Mountainous or heavily timbered land or land covered with dense undergrowth and exceptionally difficult to survey, 83.24 chs.
