82.75	The cor. of secs. 5, 6, 7 and 8. Land, mountainous. Soil, clay and granite, 2nd and 3rd rate. Timber, Fir, Hemlock, Pine. Undergrowth, Hemlock, Fir, Hazel, Lilac. Mountainous or heavily timbered land or land covered with dense undergrowth and exceptionally difficult to survey, 82.75 chs.
