## CHAINS

S.0\*1'E. bet. secs. 16 and 17.

Over mountainous land, heavily timbered and covered with dense undergrowth.

Asc. NW. slope.

18.25 Divide bet. Coffee Creek and S. Umpqua River bears NE. and SW.

Trail to Perdue bears NE. and SW.

20.00 A cabin bears W. 100 lks. dist.

22.50 Desc. SE. slope.

37.90 Creek, 1 lk. wide, course E.

40.00 Set a basalt stone 14x8x6 ins., 9 $\frac{1}{2}$  ins. in the ground, for  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. cor. on E. Bdy. sec. 17 only ( $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. cor. on W. bdy. sec. 16 to be established 40.00 chs. from the S.) marked  $\frac{1}{4}$  on W. face, from which,

A Fir, 8 ins. diam., bears S.59\*W., 40 lks. dist. marked  $\frac{1}{4}$  S 17 B T.

A Maple, 10 ins. diam., bears N.62\*W., 23 lks. dist. marked  $\frac{1}{4}$  S 17 B T.

Along E. slope.

46.00 Creek, 1 lk. wide, course E.

75.00 Ravine, course E.

80.00 Set a quartz stone 15x8x8 ins., 10 ins. in the ground, for cor. of secs. 17 and 20 ( line bet. secs. 16 and 21 to be extended W. from  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. cor.) marked with 3 notches on S. edge, from which,

A Fir, 20 ins. diam., bears S.54\*W., 24 lks. dist. marked T 30 S R 2 W S 20 B T.

A Fir, 40 ins. diam., bears N.35\*W., 51 lks. dist. marked T 30 S R 2 W S 17 B T.

Land, mountainous.

Soil, clay and stony, 2nd and 3rd. rate.

Timber, Fir, Hemlock, Cedar.

Undergrowth, Hemlock, Vine Maple, Hazel.

Mountainous or heavily timbered land or land covered with dense undergrowth and exceptionally difficult
