CHAINS

A. W. Marshall, in sec. 4, has a 5 room log house, 22x26 ft. inside, barn, chicken house and sheds, chicken park, 4 acres cleared, 2 acres cultivated, well, 1 mile of fence, 50 fruit trees, 18 head of cattle, 1 horse. Estimated value, \$900.

Hubbard, Buker, Kauffman and the Marshalls have made three miles of new trail to Tiller on practicable wagon road route and have taken steps to have a county road established.

A. J. Potiers, in sec. 16, has a house 24x16 ft., 2 rooms barn 28x18 ft., 25 acres slashed, 15 acres in cultivation, 2 horses, 1 cow. Estimated value, \$1000.

Dr. Edson B. Russell, in sec. 16, has a $1\frac{1}{2}$ story house, 20x24 ft., sheep shed, 20x50 ft., woodshed, 10x18 ft., roothouse, 10x10 ft., 4 acres cleared, $\frac{3}{4}$ acre. in garden, 400 berry plants, 6 grape vines. Estimated value, \$500.
