CHAINS	<p>10 miles 7 chs. and 1 lk. of these exterior lines run over mountainous land covered with heavy timber or dense undergrowth 2 chs. and 69 lks. of the connecting lines run over mountainous land through heavy timber or dense undergrowth, 1 mile 40 chs. and 11 lks. retraced over mountainous land through heavy timber or dense undergrowth.</p>
	<p style="text-align: center;">General Description</p> <p>This township is mountainous and is covered with heavy timber and brush. There is some good Laurel along the South Fork of the Umpqua River.</p>
	<p>In running these exterior lines I examined the adjustments of my compass and took the latitude daily.</p>
	<p>As there was no officer authorized to administer oaths, other than myself available, without great delay and expense I administered the required preliminary and final oaths to my assistants.</p>
