T 30 S S 10 on NE R 3 W S 15 on SE S 16 on SW and S 9 on NW faces, with 3 notches on E. and 4 notches on S. edges, from which

A Fir, 14 ins. diam., bears N.60°E., 14½ lks. dist., marked T 30 S R 3 W S 10 B T.

A Laurel, 7 ins. diam., bears S.10½°E., 33 lks. dist., marked T 30 S R 3 W S 15 B T.

A Fir, 14 ins. diam., bears S.20½°W., 76 lks. dist., marked T 30 S R 3 W S 16 B T.

A Laurel, 10 ins. diam., bears N.61 3/4°W., 44 lks. dist., marked T 30 S R 3 W S 9 B T.

Land, mountainous. 80.00 chs.

Soil, 3rd rate.

Heavily timbered with Fir, Laurel and Maple. 80.00 chs.

Dense undergrowth of Vine Maple, Hazel, Laurel,

Chinquapin and Fir. South 40.00 chs.

S.89°45'E., on a random line between secs. 10 and 15.
