This township is mountainous. It is mostly covered with Fir, Laurel, Cedar and Hemlock timber. The soil is mostly 3rd rate. There is some good land along the S. Fork of the Umpqua River, which will produce good crops without irrigation. The township is well watered by the S. Fork of the Umpqua River and numerous mountain streams of pure clear water.
