CHAINS

marked T 30 S S 34 on NE., R 4 W S 3 on SE.,
T 31 S S 4 on SW., S 33 on NW. faces with 3 notches
on E. and W. edges, from which

A Fir, 33 ins. in diam., bears N.55½*E., 64 lks.
dist., marked T 30 S R 4 W S 34 B T.

A Fir, 30 ins. diam., bears S.76*E., 59 lks.
dist., marked T 31 S R 4 W S 3 B T.

A Fir, 16 ins. diam., bears S.52*W., 12 lks.
dist., marked T 31 S R 4 W S 4 B T.

A Laurel, 12 ins. diam., bears N.42*W., 17 lks.
dist., marked T 30 S R 4 W S 33 B T.

Land, mountainous.

Soil, coarse gravel; 3rd rate.

Timber, Fir, Laurel and Cedar.

Underbrush, Hazel, Huckleberry, young Laurels and Firs.

June 3rd, 1889.

Var. 19*E.

West, on true line bet. Secs. 33 and 4.

Descend through Fir timber with heavy underbrush.

5.00 Enter a sloping timber flat.

14.50 A branch, course SW., 1 lk. wide; begin slight ascent.

16.50 Top of rise, begin descent.

+60

20.50 A branch, course NW., 3 lks. wide; begin steep ascent.

34.00 Top of rise on the N. end of spur, course E. and W.

+700

Begin descent.

40.00 Set a Fir post, 3 ft. long, 3 ins. sq., 24 ins. in the
ground, for ¼ Sec. Cor., marked ¼ S on N. face,
from which
