

Subdivisions of T. 30 S., R. 4 W.

CHAINS

At point of intersection is a Laurel, 5 ins. diam., which I marked Cor. to Secs. 1, 2, 35 and 36, T 30 S S 36 on NE., R 4 W S 1 on SE., T 31 S S 2 on SW., S 35 on NW. faces, with 1 notch on E., 5 notches on W. edges, from which

A Laurel, 4 ins. diam., bears N.41 $\frac{3}{4}$ *E., 17 lks. dist., marked T 30 S R 4 W S 36 B T.

A Laurel, 6 ins. diam., bears S.41 $\frac{1}{2}$ *E., 19 lks. dist., marked T 31 S R 4 W S 1 B T.

A Fir, 9 ins. diam., bears S.31*W., 35 lks. dist., marked T 31 S R 4 W S 2 B T.

A Fir, 10 ins. diam., bears N.59 $\frac{3}{4}$ *W., 626 lks. dist., marked T 30 S R 4 W S 35 B T.

Land, mountainous.

Soil, coarse gravel; 3rd rate.

Timber, mostly Fir and Laurel.

Undergrowth, young Firs and Laurel.

Var. 19*15'E.

Returning to the Cor. to Secs. 23, 24, 25 and 26, I run East, on random line bet. Secs. 24 and 25.

37.05 Intersected East Bdy. of Tp., 26.23 chs. S. of Cor. to Secs. 19, 24, 25 and 30, which is a W. Oak post, 4 ins. sq., firmly set in the ground, marked T 30 S S 19 on NE., R 3 W S 30 on SE., R 4 W S 25 on SW., S 24 on NW. faces with 4 notches on N. and 2 notches on S. edges, from which

A Laurel, 14 ins. diam., bears N.40*E., 33 lks. dist., marked T 30 S R 3 W S 19 B T.

A Laurel, 24 ins. diam., bears S.45*E., 40 lks. dist., marked T 30 S R 3 W S 30 B T.

A Laurel, 14 ins. diam., bears S.47*W., 36 lks.
