Thiel, to-wit:</p> <p>A rock corner 24x11x6 ins., 2 notches on E. and 4 on S. edges, from which</p> <p style="padding-left: 40px;">A Fir, 20 ins. diam., bears N.5*E., 97 lks. dist., marked T 30 S R 4 W S 12 B T.</p> <p style="padding-left: 40px;">A Fir, 7 ins. diam., bears S.85*E., 37 lks. dist., marked T 30 S R 4 W S 13 B T.</p> <p style="padding-left: 40px;">A Fir, 18 ins. diam., bears S.5*W., 55 lks. dist., marked T 30 S R 4 W S 14 B T.</p> <p style="padding-left: 40px;">A Fir, 8 ins. diam., bears N.53*W., 35 lks. dist., marked T 30 S R 4 W S 11 B T.</p> <p>Altitude, 2240 feet.</p> <p>Thence</p> <p>East, between Secs. 12 and 13, T. 30 S., R. 4 W.</p> <p style="text-align: right;">Var. 18 3/4*E.</p> <p>5.00 Enter open prairie.</p> <p>7.50 Top of rock ridge, course S.80*W.</p> <p>Altitude, 2545 ft., 1635 ft. above valley.</p> <p>39.52 Intersect Tp. line, set W. T 30 S., R. 3 W., bears N.2*E., 22.31 chs.</p> <p>Ascend steep hill.</p>
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
