

Subdivisions of T.30 S., R. 4 W.

CHAINS		
15.50	A ravine, course E. and ascend.	+75
20.00	Descend.	-60
25.10	A stream, 1 lk. wide, course SE., ascend.	+100
27.60	A Fir, 5 ft. diam., on line marked with 2 notches on N. and S. sides.	
28.50	Descend.	-500
40.00	A Maple, 4 ins. diam., which I mark $\frac{1}{4}$ S on W. face, for $\frac{1}{4}$ Sec. Cor., from which A Fir, 8 ins. diam., bears S.88 $\frac{1}{2}$ *E., 39 lks. dist., marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S B T. A Laurel, 6 ins. diam., bears N.58 $\frac{3}{4}$ *W., 32 lks. dist., marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S B T.	
43.90	Intersect the South Bdy. of the Tp. 4.50 chs. West of the Cor. to Secs. 2, 3, 34 and 35 and set temporary post, which Cor. is a fir tree, 6 ins. diam., marked T 30 S S 35 on NE., R 4 W S 2 on SE., T 31 S S 3 on SW., and S 34 on NW. faces, with 2 notches on E. and 4 notches on W. edges, from which, A Maple, 6 ins. diam., bears N.25*E., 41 lks. dist., marked T 30 S R 4 W S 35 B T. A Fir, 36 ins. diam., bears S.17 $\frac{1}{2}$ *E., 97 lks. dist., marked T 31 S R 4 W S 2 B T. A Fir, 36 ins. diam., bears S.45 $\frac{1}{2}$ *W., 53 lks. dist., marked T 31 S R 4 W S 3 B T. A Fir, 8 ins. diam., bears N.67 $\frac{1}{2}$ *W., 14 lks. dist., marked T 30 S R 4 W S 34 B T. As this closing is not within the prescribed limits, I begin at the corner to Secs. 25, 26, 35 and 36. Thence I run South, on a blank line between Secs. 35 and 36. Var. 19 $\frac{1}{4}$ *E. Ascend in timber and brush.	
22.75	Top of ridge, course NW. and SE., descend.	+400 -200
