A Fir, 24 ins. diam., bears N.22\*E., 53 lks. dist., marked  $\frac{1}{4}$  S B T.

A Laurel, 3 ins. diam., bears S.5\*W., 10 lks. dist., marked  $\frac{1}{4}$  S B T.

To a point 4 lks. East of the Cor. to Secs. 1, 2, 35 and 36, which is a laurel tree, 6 ins. diam., broken off 8 ft. above the ground, marked T 30 S S 36 on NE., R 3 W S 1 on SE., T 31 S S 2 on SW., and S 35 on NW. faces, with 1 notch on E. and 5 notches on W. edges, from which

A Laurel, 4 ins. diam., bears N.41  $\frac{3}{4}$ \*E., 17 lks. dist., marked T 30 S R 4 W S 36 B T.

A Laurel, 6 ins. diam., bears S.41  $\frac{1}{2}$ \*E., 19 lks. dist., marked T 31 S R 4 W S 1 B T.

A Fir, 9 ins. diam., bears S.31\*W., 35 lks. dist., marked T 31 S R 4 W S 2 B T.

A Fir, 10 ins. diam., bears N.59  $\frac{3}{4}$ \*W., 62 lks. dist., marked T 30 S R 4 W S 35 B T.

Land, mountainous. 43.55 chs.

Soil, 3d. rate.

Timber, heavy with fir, laurel, chinquapin and maple. 22.00 chs.
