CHAINS

A Fir, 30 ins. diam., bears S.76°E., 59 lks. dist.,
marked T 31 S R 4 W S 3 B T.

A Fir, 16 ins. diam., bears S.52°W., 12 lks. dist.,
marked T 30 S R 4 W S 4 B T.

A Laurel, 12 ins. diam., bears N.42°W., 17 lks. dist.,
marked T 30 S R 4 W S 33 B T.

As this is not the corner to Secs. 33 and 34 I destroy
the marks on the NE. and NW. faces of this corner and
the mark on the witness trees North of this line in
T. 30 S., R. 4 W.

Land, mountainous. 77.96 chs.

Soil, 3d rate.

Timber, heavy with Fir, Laurel, Cedar, Chinquapin and
Maple. 77.96 chs.

Undergrowth, dense with Vine-maple, Laurel, Huckleberry,
Arrow-wood, Hazel, Hemlock, Fir and logs. 77.00 chs.

At a point of intersection a White Fir, 5 ins. diam.,
for closing Cor. to Secs. 33 and 34, which I mark
C C T 30 S R 4 W on N., S 34 on E., and S 33 on W.
faces, with 3 notches on E. and W. faces; from which
An Alder, 10 ins. diam., bears N.83½°E., 36½ lks.
dist., marked T 30 S R 4 W S 34 B T.

A Fir, 8 ins. diam., bears N.36½°W., 31 lks. dist.,
marked T 30 S R 4 W S 33 B T.

A Fir, 10 ins. diam., bears S.56°E., 17 lks. dist.,
marked T 30 S R 4 W C C S 33 and 34 B T.

Land, mountainous. 44.75 chs.

Soil, 3d rate.

Timber, heavy with Fir, Laurel and Maple. 15.00 chs.

Undergrowth, dense with Vine-maple, Laurel, Hemlock,
Arrow-wood, Cedar, Fir and Chinquapin, and logs.
