Subdivisions of T. 30 S., R. 5 W., W. M.

CHAINS	
14.25	A branch, 5 lks. wide, course SE, 350 ft. below Sec. cor, begin ascent through dense undergrowth of small firs.
18.60	Trail, bears SE and NW.
24.24	A branch 2 lks. wide, in canyon, course W., begin ascent of W. slope through oak timber, about 200 ft. above first branch mentioned.
40.00	<p>A point, about 350 ft. above last branch, I set a laurel post, 3 ft. long, 3 ins. sq. 24 ins. in the ground for $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. marked, $\frac{1}{4}$ S on W face, from which,</p> <p>A B oak, 22 ins. diam., bears S.5*W, 24 lks. dist. marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S B T.</p> <p>A fir, 7 ins. diam., bears S.43$\frac{1}{2}$*E, 8 lks. dist. marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S B T.</p>
42.50	Top of ridge, 60 ft. above $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor, bears E. & W. Begin descent through dense undergrowth.
52.00	Foot of descent, about 75 ft. below top of ridge, begin ascent, an empty house stands E. about 2.50 chs.
56.00	Begin very steep ascent, through oak timber, bears E & W.
67.00	Top of ridge, bears E & W., 400 ft. above the house, begin descent through heavy undergrowth of hazel and arrow-wood.
80.00	<p>A maple, tree 5 ins. diam., 200 ft. below top of ridge, which I mark for cor. to secs. 1, 2, 11 and 12.</p> <p>T 30 S S 1 on NE., R 5 W S 12 on SE., S 11 on SW., S 2 on NW sides, with 5 notches on S. and 1 notch on E. sides, from which,</p> <p>A maple, 15 ins. diam., bears N.72*E, 55 lks. dist. marked T 30 S R 5 W S 1 B T.</p> <p>A fir, 24 ins. diam., bears S.33*E, 24 lks. dist. marked T 30 S R 5 W S 12 B T.</p> <p>A willow, 5 ins. diam., bears S.35*W, 31 lks. dist. marked T 30 S R 5 W S 11 B T.</p> <p>A fir, 36 ins. diam., bears N.31$\frac{1}{2}$*W, 33 lks. dist. marked T 30 S R 5 W S 2 B T.</p>
