

## Subdivisions of T. 30 S., R. 5 W.

CHAINS

79.96 Intersect N. and S. line 48 lks. N. of cor. of secs.  
1, 2, 11 and 12.

July 20, 1896

Thence I run,

N.89°57'W, on a true line bet. secs. 2 and 11.

Sharp descent through a thicket of hazels and small firs.

1.50 A dim trail, bears SW and NE.

2.65 A creek, 2 lks. wide, in a canyon, course SW, 60 ft.  
below sec. cor., begin steep ascent through fir timber  
and heavy underbrush.

10.50 Top of ridge, 300 ft. above creek, bears SW and NE,  
begin descent of NW. slope through small firs.

19.75 A trail, bears N. and S.

21.65 A branch, 4 lks. wide, course S., 350 ft. below ridge,  
begin steep ascent through fir timber.

37.00 Top of ridge, bears N and S., 500 ft. above branch,  
go along SW slope.

39.98 Set a fir post 3 ft. long, 3 ins. sq. 24 ins. in the  
ground for  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. cor. marked  $\frac{1}{4}$  S on N. face, from  
which,

A W oak, 12 ins. diam., bears N.74°W, 17 lks. dist.  
marked  $\frac{1}{4}$  S B T.

A W oak, 14 ins. diam., bears S.25 $\frac{1}{2}$ °W., 23 lks. dist.  
marked  $\frac{1}{4}$  S B T.

48.00 Enter oak and fir timber, bears N. and S.  
Begin descent.

51.20 A gulch, course SW, 80 ft. below  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. cor.  
Begin ascent.

54.75 Top of ascent, begin descent.

60.50 A gulch, course S. 300 ft. below  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. cor. begin  
moderate ascent.

66.50 An empty house bears S., about 4.00 chs. dist.

71.10 A spring, is S. about 1.00 chain, begin steep ascent  
through oak timber.

79.96 The cor. of secs. 2, 3, 10 and 11.
