Begin to ascend.

57.75

Top of ridge, begin to descend, 800 ft. above foot of descent.

75.10

The cor. to secs. 34 & 35.

80.75

The closing cor. to secs. 3 & 2.

Land, mountainous.

Soil, gravelly; 3rd. rate.

Timber, oak laurel, fir, pine.

Dense undergrowth, of small fir, oaks, laurel, hazel, poisoned oak.

Mountainous, land. 80.75 chs.

July 28, 1896.

N189°42'E, along North bdy. of sec. 2.

Descend, through heavy undergrowth, of black oak grubbs.

8.25

A branch, 2 lks. wide, course N., 150 ft. below closing cor., enter fir timber, bears N & S, begin ascent.

29.85

A canyon, course NW., begin ascent of a spur, bears N & S., covered by black oak grubbs, partly burnt.

42.10

Begin to descent, the fire, that appears to have raged here about 8 years ago, has destroyed all the timber, and the $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor with its witness trees; a young growth of black oaks of about 2 ins. diam., covers this spur.

45.50

A gulch, course NW, begin ascent close to gulch.

52.00

Cross same gulch, keep ascending N, slope.

79.44

Intersect a prologation N. of the random line bet. secs. 1 & 2.

I set a temp. post.

Land, mountainous.

Soil, gravelly, 3rd. rate.

Timber, oak, laurel, fir, pine.

Dense undergrowth, of small oaks, firs, laurel, hazel, poisoned oak.

Mountainous, land. 79.44 chs.
