	<p>GENERAL DESCRIPTION:</p> <p>The north and west part of this township is very broken and intersperced with open grass hills and ridges; well adapted to grazing, but not for cultivation.</p> <p>The valley of Cow Creek, situated in the south and east part of the township is first rate land, and well adapted to cultivation.</p> <p>It is well timbered with the various kinds of oak, fir, pine, sugar-pine, laurel and ash.</p>

80.00	<p>Not being able to close within limits to the posts previously established on the east boundary of Tp. 30 S., R 6 W., I commenced as per "Aduenda to Special Instructions" at SE cor. of Tp above named and measured north on the line before established and at a distance of 39.60 chs., passed $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. post, the same being within limits, I did not establish a new cor. Thence north on line before established and at a distance of 78.60 chs., passed corner for secs. 30, 36, 25 and 31.</p> <p>Set post, cor to secs. 30, 36, 25 and 31, from which a B Oak, 12 ins. diam., bears S.68*E., 67 lks. dist. B Oak, 8 ins. diam., bears N.65*E., 110 lks. dist. B Oak, 2 ins. diam., bears N.71*W., 37 lks. dist. W Oak, 15 ins. diam., bears S.33*W., 90 lks. dist. Also a small mound of stones around the post.</p>
40.00	<p>Thence north on previously established line and at a distance of 38.05 chs., passed quarter post and at a distance of ^{2511.3'}</p> <p>Set quarter sec. post, from which a B Oak, 5 ins. diam., bears S.72*E., 100 lks. dist.</p>
